GOALS

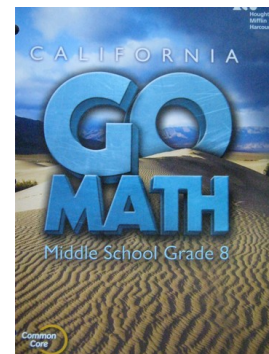
